Here is a view of the Overcomer tabernacle at Canady's Farm in South Carolina. This is the house of prayer we speak about on air.

It is here at this location that about 70 saints – families, single brothers and sisters live in common unity.

We have all come to join together in the preparing for the soon coming of Jesus and to be set apart from the world to be able to live a sanctified life.

We live in community homes of mobile trailers for each family or accommodations for brothers or sisters with common baths and common eating, all seeking to live together in love for God and each other.

We do not go anywhere as we need not do so. We work the farm and have our school and with the simple life; we need very little that the world offers.

All have given all their worldly goods and monies to the Lord, large or small, and no one owes anyone anything

but to love and no one owns anything.

We give all and if after time they desire to leave, they claim nothing in return and make no demands on the community or ministry to secure any funds to go back into the world system.

You do not join yourself to us, as we are the church that only God can join together by the Holy Spirit.

Anyone that seems to be led to come live here or any community needs to first visit and make known their situation. That must be cleared and can be done by a timely visit to see and know if you really can live in this simple manner in peace with others of like faith.

Enclosed are the community rules and the address to write to set the time for the visit.

You will be questioned as to your family situation and willingness to be separate from them and other things of the world. You must be

willing to add support in both work and finances to maintain the community and to be free from debt. We go nowhere, no shopping, or trips to see what have you. Your life will be here on the farm until Jesus comes.

Be sure that if you desire to be in God's will and want to be a part of this community that you fully understand that this is a way of life we have chosen to wait until the Lord doth come.

We do not believe you have to live here or as we do to be saved.

You must be in God's will to be saved.

The Law of the House.

Residents agree to and comply with.

The residents of the Overcomer Ministry at 12680 Augusta Highway Walterboro, S.C. 29488 agree to live at peace one with another subject to the following constraints.

The man of God (Brother Stair) shall have sole discretion to judge the legitimacy of need and to direct distribution to satisfy the need.

A curfew is imposed from the hours of 10:00 P.M. until 4:00 A.M.

The gates on the lanes existing on State Hwy 61 (Augusta Highway) will be locked at 10:00 P.M. and opened in the morning as need requires. Residents will restrict themselves to their dwellings during the hours of curfew unless special permission is granted by the man of God (Brother Stair).

The residents submit to the authority of the Word of God and understand the central, dominant and primary place preaching has in our chosen life. They also acknowledge the right of the man of God to discipline and direct and correct residents who exhibit unbiblical behavior.

The residents recognize the practice of shunning as necessary in correcting the

unrepentant and insubordinate.

The residents recognize expulsion from the community as a sanction of last resort for the rebelliously unrepentant.

Residents choosing to leave the Community are not entitled to recover any gifts or offerings or contributions previously given to Faith Cathedral Fellowship, Inc.

The community will help those that leave as God directs and as available resources permit.

We send this brochure to you at your request for information on how one can become part of the Overcomer family and live with them here on the farm.

We in no wise are seeking any to do so as we know that many cannot nor will not give up all worldly desires and possessions to live in this simple life as a testimony to our Lord's cause to witness to His soon return.
